There have been hundreds of hours of prayer, planning, paperwork, printing, and preparation by the SJBA Student Ministry Team, Children's Camp Leadership Team, Camp Pastor, Camp Worship Leader, Bible Study Leaders, Muriel Elder, and myself. Dozens of Volunteers, many who take their vacation time, will spend a week ministering to children and adults alike.
